

Getting Here

Church Stretton is 13 miles south of Shrewsbury and 15 miles north of Ludlow just off the A49 trunk road.

There are regular bus and rail services into the town.



Church Stretton is the starting point for the Shropshire Hills Shuttle buses which give easy access into the hills over the Long Mynd, the Stiperstones and Wenlock Edge every weekend and Bank Holiday from April/May to September.
