Participation in Church Stretton Business Survey

Church Stretton Town Council has commissioned students from the Business School at Chester University to undertake an on-line survey of local businesses. The purpose of the survey is to develop a profile of businesses in the local area and to identify ways in which they can be better supported, not only by the Town Council but also by Shropshire Council, the Marches Economic Growth Hub and local colleges.

The Council would like to encourage as many local businesses as possible to contribute to this survey, which will take less than 30 minutes to complete. The Council currently only has a limited data-base of contact details for local businesses and those currently on the database will shortly be receiving direct invitations to complete the survey before the 15th June 2019.
